## **Environmental Program Delivery**

**Eligible Activity: Section 105 (a)**

**National Objective: Presumed by activity**

**Activity Amount: \$5,283,475**

This amendment transfers \$1 million within the Repair Rebuild Restore program to the environmental program delivery which supports environmental reviews on all project areas. This increase is necessary as a number of programs have required more environmental reviews than initially budgeted. This amendment is considered non-substantial since the transfer will be less than the 15% threshold.

### **Monitoring**

This activity is considered to be a low risk activity. Monitoring will be performed by the Office of Community Development staff in accordance with the contracts and the Infrastructure Monitoring Plan.
