

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 43 (First Appropriation)
FOR FY 2006 CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS

April 28, 2010

The proposed Action Plan Amendment provides for additional activities under the homeowner program to accomplish the dual goals of providing assistance to homeowners and rebuilding neighborhoods. It provides for a housing counseling approach and includes the availability of construction lending as an additional tool to enable homeowners to reoccupy their homes and meet the requirements of their original Road Home covenant. These activities will serve only existing Road Home recipients; it does not expand the program to additional participants.

The proposed amendment was developed with regard to the federal supplemental appropriation for Hurricanes Katrina and Rita disaster recovery and rebuilding efforts administered by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. The public is invited to comment on this proposed action plan before it is sent to HUD for approval.
