

**MINUTES OF THE  
LOUISIANA ARCHITECTS SELECTION BOARD  
November 16, 2022**

A meeting of the Louisiana Architects Selection Board (LASB) was held in the Claiborne Building, 1201 N. Third Street, Room 1-100 Louisiana Purchase Room, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70802 on November 16, 2022.
