#### 2008 - 2009 FISCAL YEAR STATUS

For the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009, the total reported state expenditure on contracts with certified small entrepreneurships was approximately \$28,226,936. For the previous fiscal year the total state expenditure on contracts with certified small entrepreneurships was approximately \$69,240,797. The table below is an overview of expenditures to Hudson Initiative certified small entrepreneurships for fiscal years July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 and July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

### ADDITIONAL INITIATIVE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY **STATUTE**

La. R.S. 39:2007(C) requires the Commissioner of Administration to provide periodic training for relevant state employees to acquaint them with the requirements of the initiative and administrative law related thereto.

On behalf of the commissioner, the Office of State Purchasing conducted a Hudson Initiative seminar in conjunction with the LaNIGP (Louisiana National Institute of Governmental Purchasing) 13th Annual Education Conference and Products Exposition which was held on November 5, 2009.

B. La.R.S.39:2007(D) requires the Commissioner of Administration to conduct a training program at least semiannually to acquaint small entrepreneurships with state procurement and public contract proposal and bidding practices.

On behalf of the commissioner, the Office of State Purchasing conducted outreach activities to acquaint small entrepreneurships with state contracting and procurement and to encourage certification as small entrepreneurships and to encourage small entrepreneurships to enroll in the state's electronic vendor notification system, LaPAC.
