Dear President Henry and Speaker DeVillier:

The Division of Administration, Office of Community Development (OCD), a rulemaking agency, hereby submits the following summary report in accordance with La. R.S. 49:966K.

The OCD has taken no action with respect to adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule as the OCD proposed no such rule during 2025; the OCD has taken no action with respect to any proposed fee adoption, increase, or decrease as the OCD proposed no such fee during 2025; and, the OCD did not respond to any petition or submission under La. R.S. 49:961 as the OCD received no such petitions or submissions during 2025.

In accordance with La. R.S. 49:964B, OCD conducted a public hearing in the Thomas Jefferson Room, 1-136C, First Floor of the Claiborne Building, 1201 N. Third Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, on October 28, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. The OCD received no comments at the hearing or during the comment period.

In 2025, OCD began rules for the Local Government Assistance Program (LGAP) and Community Water Enrichment Fund (CWEF) Program. OCD considered implementing a minimum award amount requirement for local governments and reviewed the level of funding set aside for emergencies. OCD did not make any changes to these rules. In 2026, the office will continue reviewing its rules for the five-year period of 2025-2029 in accordance with R.S. 49:964D, enacted by Act 192 (2024 R.S.) and effective August 1, 2024.
