

Tax Exemption for LaCarte Purchasing Card

The tax-exempt number associated with the State of Louisiana card programs is printed on the front of the LaCarte Card. This number should be provided only to the cardholder and must not be published on any public forum.

The Office of State Travel does not manage tax-exempt numbers for vendors when using the LaCarte Card. Some vendors—such as Wal-Mart, Home Depot, and Lowe’s—require each agency to establish its own tax-exempt status. The tax exemption applies only to vendors located in the State of Louisiana and only for Louisiana state sales taxes when the LaCarte Card is used as the form of payment.
