SUBJECT: Preparations for TS Cristobal

Current weather predictions indicate Louisiana will be impacted by heavy rains and wind when TS Cristobal makes landfall. TS Cristobal is predicted to make landfall the latter part of this weekend to early this coming Monday. State agencies are encouraged to immediately take precautionary measures to elevate all movable property, including valuable papers, vehicles and heavy machinery, and equipment to higher ground to minimize the potential damage from rising water.

Should an agency sustain a loss to buildings, contents, vehicles or equipment they should promptly report their loss to **Sedgwick CMS**. Claim reporting instructions and forms can be found online. The link to the claims reporting website is:
