SUBJECT: Notice of Availability of Proposed FY 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan & FY 2025 Consolidated Annual Action Plan

As set forth in 24 CFR Part 91, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires state agencies which administer certain HUD programs to incorporate their planning and application requirements into one master plan called the Consolidated Plan. In Louisiana, the three state agencies participating in this consolidated planning process and the HUD funded program(s) administered by each agency include the Division of Administration/Office of Community Development (CDBG), the Louisiana Housing Corporation (HOME Investment Partnerships Program, National Housing Trust Fund, and Emergency Solutions Grants Program), and the Louisiana Department of Health, Office of Public Health, STD/HIV/Hepatitis Program (Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Program).

A proposed Consolidated Plan for FY 2025 – FY 2029 has been prepared; that document identifies housing and community development needs and a strategy for meeting those needs for federal fiscal years 2025 – 2029. It includes a one-year action plan for the proposed method of distribution of the FY 2025 federal funds which will be received under the aforementioned programs. An annual update, or action plan, for the distribution of funds will be prepared and publicized for each of the subsequent four program years.

The proposed Consolidated Plan for FY 2025 – FY 2029 and the proposed FY 2025 Consolidated Annual Action Plan funds under the HUD programs will be available for review beginning June 17, 2025, at <https://www.doa.la.gov/doa/ocd-lga/lcdbg-programs/lcdbg-plans-and-reports/2025-2029/> and at the Office of Community Development, Claiborne Building, Suite 3-150, 1201 North Third Street in Baton Rouge. Copies of the document will also be available for review at the Louisiana Housing Corporation at 2415 Quail Drive in Baton Rouge, and at the Department of Health and Hospitals, Office of Public Health, STD/HIV Program at 1450 Poydras Street, Suite 2136, in New Orleans.

Written comments on the proposed consolidated annual action plan may be submitted beginning June 17, 2025, and must be received no later than July 17, 2025.
