### STATE OF LOUISIANA LOUISIANA WORKFORCE COMMISSION INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

Be it known, that the Louisiana Workforce Commission (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "LWC" or State) and Louisiana State Fire Marshal's Office on behalf of the Louisiana Fire and Emergency Training Academy (FETA) (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Contractor"), 8181 Independence Blvd, Baton Rouge, La, 70806, do hereby enter into contract under the following terms and conditions.

#### **Term of Contract**

This contract shall begin on July 1, 2022 and end on June 30, 2023.

#### Goals

The goal of this agreement is to increase the level of certification, qualification, skills, and abilities of the Louisiana Fire Service by increasing the number of firefighters able to attend the Louisiana FETA Firefighter Training Academy and those in need of additional medical-related certifications to qualify for jobs, promotions, and/or wage increases. We also believe this will, in turn, address an additional, ongoing goal of increasing the fire service workforce and volunteerism figures which have been on a concerning decline over the past decade. In addition, this partnership allows Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC) to continue and further its goal of putting people to work and growing a qualified, competitive workforce by providing financial resources to cover critical training in the fire and emergency response industry.

#### Objectives

The objectives of this agreement are to:

- Increase interest in becoming part of the Louisiana Fire Service and emergency responder
  community by 25% by the end of the contract term (12 months). This would be measured
  by polling the participating fire departments at the end of the contract term to determine
  any increase in headcount of either career or volunteer members.
- Max-out attendance of all three of the training opportunities presented in this agreement that are scheduled within the contract term (12 months)
- Increase the quality of fixefighters and emergency responders protecting our communities across Louisiana by aiming for an 85% pass rate of all training opportunities outlined in this agreement
- Decrease the financial burden on participating fire departments, paid and volunteer, by at least \$4,000 within the contract term (12 months) to have their memberships appropriately trained by reducing the cost they incur to send members to be trained in order for those costs to be utilized for other priorities like up-to-date PPE, gear, equipment, and vehicles

- Increase partnerships over the contract term (12 months) between fire departments and FETA by fostering relationships with at least 6 new departments that have not utilized FETA's training programs or facilities within the past five years.
- Foster a successful, long-term partnership with LWC to continually improve the quality
  of Louisiana's Fire Service, and the safety of the communities they serve, to further
  LWC's mission by qualifying/certifying 85% of all participants of the three training
  opportunities presented in this agreement over the contract term (12 months).

- Three, 14-week Fire Fighter academies held in the contract time frame that feature a maximum of 32 attendees each.
  - Of the attendees, on average, 28 tend to be fire department-sponsored attendees
    which come at a cost of \$3,800 per person due to the department's providing their
    PPE and gear.
  - o Of the attendees, on average, 4 tend to be independent applicants which come at a cost of \$8,800 per person due to the individual having to rent or purchase PPE/gear via FETA.
  - The total number of anticipated attendees of all three classes scheduled within this contract period (September, January, April) would be 96.
  - The total cost to cover every attendee of all three classes scheduled within this contract period (September, January, April) would be \$424,800.
  - o The request for this contract period would cover 25 attendees per session (2 of them independent), for a total number of 75 attendees (6 independent) in the total time frame with a maximum cost of \$315,000.

- Class rosters would be used to measure the objective of maxing-out attendance at all
  three of the FETA Firefighter Training Academies scheduled within the contract term (12
  months)
- The issuance of certificates from each training opportunity would be the measurement standard for the objective of increasing the quality of firefighters and emergency responders protecting our communities across Louisiana by aiming for an 85% pass rate of all training opportunities outlined in this agreement
- FETA will be able to show at least one member of each participating department being
  provided a \$0 balance bill by the end of the contract term (12 months) to measure the
  objective of decreasing the financial burden on participating fire departments, paid and
  volunteer, by at least \$4,000 within the contract term (12 months)
- FETA will be able to provide the names of the six departments and contact for the
  departments that develop the 6 new partnerships as outlined in the objective to increase
  partnerships over the contract term (12 months) between fire departments and FETA by
  fostering relationships with at least 6 new departments that have not utilized FETA's
  training programs or facilities within the past five years.
- The issuance of certificates from each training opportunity would be the measurement standard for the objective of fostering a successful, long-term partnership with LWC to continually improve the quality of Louisiana's Fire Service, and the safety of the communities they serve, to further LWC's mission by qualifying/certifying 85% of all participants of the training opportunities presented in this agreement over the contract term (12 months).

#### Monitoring Plan

Lisa Williams, LWC Contractor Administrator and Rufus Nwegu, Grants Coordinator/Contract Monitor, will ensure adherence to the requirements and completion of services in accordance with the terms of this contract.

Thomas Stone, Deputy Superintendent of FETA, or his/her successor will serve as contract monitor on behalf of the State Fire Marshal's Office/FETA, to ensure adherence to the requirements and completion of services in accordance with the terms of this contract.

#### Performance Measurements

The Contractor's performance will be measured by academy/class completion figures that include employment details (employer, title, pay, etc.) for each individual upon completion. In addition, since the fire academy, specifically, conducts student evaluations every two weeks and involves meeting milestones throughout the program in order to advance to the next milestone, more frequent updates to LWC throughout each academy regarding the performance of the participants and the program, as opposed to just at the end of them, is available if desired.

### Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

Contractor agrees to make every effort to recruit and provide opportunity and access to the program for all people across differences of race, age, color, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, religion, national origin, disability, political affiliation, veteran status and socioeconomic background, embracing differences, promoting equity, fairness and access to opportunities, and fostering a culture if inclusivity by capitalizing on individual differences with an aim to foster a culture where participants feel valued, supported and inspired to achieve their individual goals of program completion and career success.

#### **Payment Terms**

In consideration of the services described above, the State hereby agrees to pay the Contractor a maximum fee of up to \$496,800. This fee is broken down by the following:

- Three, 14-week academics held in the contract time frame that feature a maximum of 32 attendees each.
  - Of the attendees, on average, 28 tend to be fire department-sponsored attendees
    which come at a cost of \$3,800 per person due to the department's providing their
    PPE and gear.
  - Of the attendees, on average, 4 tend to be independent applicants which come at a cost of \$8,800 per person due to the individual having to rent or purchase PPE/gear via FETA
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Travel and other related expenses is not reimbursable under this contract.

Payment shall be made within 30 days of receipt of invoice. Payment will be made only on approval of the Secretary of the Louisiana Workforce Commission or her designee.

#### Taxes

Contractor hereby agrees that the responsibility for payment of taxes from the funds thus received under this contract and/or legislative appropriation shall be Contractor's obligation and identified under Federal Tax Identification Number #72-0724657.

#### Termination for Causa

Should the State determine that the Contractor has failed to comply with the contract terms, the State may terminate the contract for cause by giving the Contractor written notice specifying the Contractor's failure. If the State determines that the failure is not correctable, then the contract shall terminate on the date specified in such notice. If the State determines that the failure may be corrected, the State shall give a deadline for the Contractor to make the correction. If the State determines that the failure is not corrected by the deadline, then the State may give additional time for the Contractor to make the corrections or the State may notify the Contractor of the contract termination date.

If the Contractor seeks to terminate the contract, the Contractor shall file a complaint with the Chief Procurement Officer under La. R.S. 39:1672.2-1672.4.

#### Termination for Convenience

State may terminate the contract at any time without penalty by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the Contractor of such termination or negotiating with the Contractor a termination date. Contractor shall be entitled to payment for deliverables in progress to the extent the State determines that the work is acceptable.

#### Remedies for Default

Any claim or controversy arising out of this contract shall be resolved by the provisions of LSA-R.S. 39:1672.2 – 1672.4.

#### Other Remedies

If the Contractor fails to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract, or if any lien or claim for damages, penalties, costs and the like is asserted by or against the State,

then, upon notice to the Contractor, the State may pursue all remedies available to it at law or equity, including retaining monies from amounts due the Contractor and proceeding against any surety of the Contractor.

#### Governing Law

This contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, including but not limited to La. R.S. 39:1551-1736; rules and regulations; executive orders; standard terms and conditions, special terms and conditions, and specifications listed in the RFP (if applicable); and this contract. Venue of any action brought, after exhaustion of administrative remedies, with regard to this Contract shall be in the Nineteenth Judicial District Court, Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana.

#### Record Ownership

All records, reports, documents and other material delivered or transmitted to Contractor by State shall remain the property of State, and shall be returned by Contractor to State, at Contractor's expense, at termination or expiration of this contract. All records, reports, documents, or other material related to this contract and/or obtained or prepared by Contractor in connection with the performance of the services contracted for herein shall become the property of State, and shall, upon request, be returned by Contractor to State, at Contractor's expense, at termination or expiration of this contract.

#### Commissioner's Statements

Statements, acts and omissions made by or on behalf of the Commissioner of Administration regarding the RFP or RFP process, this contract, any Contractor and/or any subcontractor of the Contractor shall not be deemed a conflict of interest when the Commissioner is discharging his duties and responsibilities under law, including, but not limited, to the Commissioner of Administration's authority in procurement matters.

#### Contractor's Cooperation

The Contractor has the duty to fully cooperate with the State and provide any and all requested information, documentation, etc. to the state when requested. This applies even if this contract is terminated and/or a lawsuit is filed. Specifically, the Contractor shall not limit or impede the State's right to audit or shall not withhold State owned documents.

#### Assignability

Contractor may assign its interest in the proceeds of this contract to a bank, trust company, or other financial institution. Within ten calendar days of the assignment, the Contractor shall provide notice of the assignment to the State and the Office of State Procurement. The State will continue to pay the Contractor and will not be obligated to direct payments to the assignee until the state has processed the assignment.

Except as stated in the preceding paragraph, Contractor shall only transfer an interest in the Contract by assignment, novation, or otherwise, with prior written consent of the State. The

State's written consent of the transfer shall not diminish the State's rights or the Contractor's responsibilities and obligations.

#### Right to Audit

Any authorized agency of the State (e.g. Office of the Legislative Auditor, Inspector General's Office, etc.) and of the Federal Government has the right to inspect and review all books and records pertaining to services rendered under this contract for a period of five years from the date of final payment under the prime contract and any subcontract. The Contractor and subcontractor shall maintain such books and records for this five-year period and cooperate fully with the authorized auditing agency. Contractor and subcontractor shall comply with federal and state laws authorizing an audit of their operations as a whole, or of specific program activities.

#### Fiscal Funding

The continuation of this contract is contingent upon the appropriation of funds to fulfill the requirements of the contract by the legislature. If the legislature fails to appropriate sufficient monies to provide for the continuation of the contract, or if such appropriation is reduced by the veto of the Governor or by any means provided in the appropriations act to prevent the total appropriation for the year from exceeding revenues for that year, or for any other lawful purpose, and the effect of such reduction is to provide insufficient monies for the continuation of the contract, the contract shall terminate on the date of the beginning of the first fiscal year for which funds are not appropriated.

#### **Discrimination Clause**

The Contractor agrees to abide by the requirements of the following nondiscrimination and equal opportunity provisions of the following laws, as applicable: Section 188 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA), as amended, which prohibits discrimination against all individuals in the United States on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, political affiliation or belief, and against beneficiaries on the basis of either citizenship/status as a lawfully admitted immigrant authorized to work in the United States or participation in any WIOA Title I financially assisted program or activity, including Title VI and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; the Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1972, as amended; the Nontraditional Employment for Women Act of 1991, as amended; Federal Executive Order 11246; Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended; the Vietnam Era Veteran's Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, as amended; the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended; Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended; the Fair Housing Act of 1968, as amended, and all applicable requirements imposed by or pursuant to regulations implementing those laws, including but not limited to 29 CFR Part 37.

Contractor agrees not to discriminate in its employment practices and shall render services under this contract without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, veteran status, political affiliation, disability, or age in any matter relating to employment. Any act of discrimination committed by Contractor, or failure to comply with these statutory obligations when applicable, shall be grounds for termination of this contract.

#### Confidentiality

All financial, statistical, personal, technical and other data and information relating to the State's operations which are designated confidential by the State and made available to the Contractor in order to carry out this contract, or which becomes available to the Contractor in carrying out this contract, shall be protected by the Contractor from unauthorized use and disclosure through the observance of the same or more effective procedural requirements as are applicable to the State. Contractor shall not be required to keep confidential any data or information which is or becomes publicly available, is already rightfully in the Contractor's possession, is independently developed by the Contractor outside the scope of this contract, or is rightfully obtained from third parties.

#### Continuing Obligation

Contractor has a continuing obligation to disclose any suspensions or debarment by any government entity, including but not limited to General Services Administration (GSA). Failure to disclosed may constitute grounds for suspension and/or termination of the contract and debarment from future contracts.

#### Cybersecurity Training

In accordance with La. R.S. 42:1267(B)(3) and the State of Louisiana's Information Security Policy, if the Contractor, any of its employees, agents, or subcontractors will have access to State government information technology assets, the Contractor's employees, agents, or subcontractors with such access must complete cybersecurity training annually, and the Contractor must present evidence of such compliance annually and upon request. The Contractor may use the cybersecurity training course offered by the Louisiana Department of State Civil Service without additional cost or may use any alternate course approved in writing by the Office of Technology Services.

For purposes of this Section, "access to State government information technology assets" means the possession of credentials, equipment, or authorization to access the internal workings of State information technology systems or networks. Examples would include but not be limited to State-issued laptops, VPN credentials to credentials to access the State network, badging to access the State's telecommunications closets or systems, or permissions to maintain or modify IT systems used by the State. Final determination of scope inclusions or exclusions relative to access to State government information technology assets will be made by the Office of Technology Services.

#### Code of Ethics

The Contractor acknowledges that Chapter 15 of Title 42 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes (R.S. 42:1101 et. seq., Code of Governmental Ethics) applies to the Contractor in the performance of services called for in this contract. The Contractor agrees to immediately notify the state if

potential violations of the Code of Governmental Ethics arise at any time during the term of this contract.

#### **Eligibility Status**

Contractor, and each tier of Subcontractors, shall certify that it is not on the List of Parties Excluded from Federal Procurement or Nonprocurement Programs promulgated in accordance with E.O.s 12549 and 12689, "Debarment and Suspension," as set forth at 24 CFR part 24.

#### Anti-Kickback Clause

Contractor agrees to adhere to the mandate dictated by the Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act which provides that each Contractor or subgrantee shall be prohibited from inducing, by any means, any person employed in the completion of work, to give up any part of the compensation to which he is otherwise entitled.

#### Clean Air Act

Contractor agrees to adhere to the provisions which require compliance with all applicable standards, orders or requirements issued under Section 306 of the Clean Air Act which prohibits the use under nonexempt Federal contracts, grants or loans of facilities included on the EPA list of Violating Facilities.

#### **Energy Policy and Conservation Act**

Contractor recognizes the mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency with are contained in the State energy conservation plan issued in compliance with the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (P.L. 94-163).

#### Clean Water Act

Contractor agrees to adhere to all applicable standards, orders, or requirements issued under Section 508 of the Clean Water Act which prohibits the use under nonexempt Federal contracts, grants, or loans of facilities included on the EPA List of Violating Facilities.

#### Prohibition of Discriminatory Boycotts of Israel

In accordance with R.S. 39:1602.1, for any contract for \$100,000 or more and for any contractor with five or more employees, the Contractor certifies that neither it nor its subcontractors are engaged in a boycott of Israel, and that the Contractor and any subcontractors for the duration of this contract, refrain from a boycott of Israel.

The State reserves the right to terminate this contract if the Contractor, or any Subcontractor, engages in a boycott of Israel during the term of the contract.

#### Anti-Lobbying

Each tier must also disclose any lobbying with non-Federal funds that takes place in connection with obtaining any Federal award. Such disclosures are forwarded from tier to tier up to the non-Federal award.

#### Amendments

Any modification to the provisions of this contract shall be in writing, signed by all parties, and approved by the required authorities.

#### **Contract Approval**

This contract is not effective until executed by all parties and approved in writing by the Office of State Procurement, in accordance with LSA-R.S. 39:1595.1.
