ALL STATE OFFICES STATEWIDE CLOSURE UPDATE

Commissioner of Administration Taylor Barras is announcing that **ALL STATE OFFICES will remain closed statewide** Thursday, September 12, 2024. Employees in areas under an evacuation order should seek further guidance from their supervisors.

Agency heads are encouraged to give special consideration to those essential personnel who will be required to work during the office closure by authorizing Special Leave (Civil Service Rule 11.23) today for those personnel to prepare and secure their family and property.

TIMEKEEPERS: This is an office closure and should be coded as such. All employees in the affected parishes, including those authorized to work from home, are required to use the office closure code (LSOC) beginning 6:00 p.m.
