Re: R.S. 49:966K Rulemaking Summary Report for 2025

Dear President Henry and Speaker DeVillier:

The Louisiana Office of Broadband Development and Connectivity (OBDC), as a rulemaking agency within the Division of Administration, hereby submits the following annual report in accordance with LA R.S. 49:966K.

- OBDC issued a Notice of Intent relative to the administration of the Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities 1.0 (GUMBO) Grant Program, effective and promulgated in the August 20, 2025, *Louisiana Register*.
- OBDC simultaneously issued an Emergency Rule and Notice of Intent relative to the administration of the Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities 2.0 (GUMBO) Grant Program, effective and promulgated in the August 20, 2025, *Louisiana Register*.
- No actions were taken by OBDC with respect to any fee adoption, increase, or decrease during 2025.
- No petitions or submissions were received by OBDC pursuant to R.S. 49:964 during 2025.
- In accordance with La. R.S. 49:964B, OBDC conducted a public hearing in the Thomas Jefferson Room, 1-136C, First Floor of the Claiborne Building, 1201 N. Third Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, on October 28, 2025, at 10:00 AM. OBDC received no comments at the hearing or during the comment period.
- In 2026, the OBDC will continue reviewing its rules for the five-year period of 2025-2029 in accordance with R.S. 49:964D, enacted by Act 192 (2024 R.S.) and effective August 1, 2024.
